#### **ORAL PRESENTATIONS 5 +5 min**

The presentation is limited to 6 slides and should be presented in a maximum of **5 minutes and 5 minutes for discussion.** Time spent is more important than number of slides. The following information is sent to the presenters in advance.

<u>Slide 1</u> should contain the abstract title, list of authors and affiliations only.

<u>Slide 2-5</u> should contain a brief introduction and clearly stated hypothesis if deemed necessary, as well as results from the abstract, preferably as figures and/or tables.

<u>Slide 6</u> should contain summary and/or conclusion(s) in bullet points.

Every slide (all 6 in every presentation) must be clearly labeled with the abstract number in the top left corner. This number will be available and provided upon confirmed acceptance of the abstract.

Your task will be to judge the presentation and pick the top three including a winner. A price of NOK 5000,- for the winner will be awarded in each session.

NOTE: The winner in each session will also be asked to give their 5 min presentation during the last session of the main program. In order to participate in the competition for best presentation, the presenter must be available for this session on Friday.
